King Township is seeking applications from qualified individuals for the contract position of Construction Inspector. With a population of approximately 24,000, King Township is a mostly rural community located 20 minutes north of Toronto in the Regional Municipality of York.

Reporting to the Deputy Director of Engineering & Development this position is responsible for the following:

- Carrying out site inspections, attending site meetings, monitoring and recording progress of work on development and capital projects.
- Ensuring that all relevant orders and/or notices are executed.
- Ensuring that construction activities are carried out in accordance with approved design and all applicable standards, specifications and codes; reporting any noticed non-compliances.
- Recommending Change Orders, when necessary.
- Interpreting construction drawings.
- Reviewing site and lot grading plans.
- Ensuring that appropriate equipment and materials are used and proper testing procedures are in place.
- Taking appropriate actions (up to and including issuance of Stop Work Orders) in cases of serious non-compliance with safety regulations.

The successful applicant will possess:

- Community college diploma in Civil Engineering Technology and a minimum of three (3) years' experience in construction inspection.
- C.E.T. designation or eligibility for certification.
- Knowledge of municipal standards, OPSS, OPSD, *Ontario Building Code*, *Occupational Health and Safety Act*, municipal by-laws and other applicable legislation.
- Knowledge of construction techniques to carry out inspections and determine non-compliances and deficiencies.
