Maintenance Mechanic Permanent, Full-Time Position

The Township of Springwater, located in the heart of Simcoe County, is a mixed urban/rural municipality with growing urban settlements and a prosperous agricultural sector. The municipality is currently recruiting for a full-time **Maintenance Mechanic**

Reporting to the Roads Supervisor Yard one (1), the **Maintenance Mechanic** is responsible for repairing, maintaining and operating vehicles and equipment for the Township's Public Works Department.

Primary Responsibilities

- Service and repair all municipal vehicles to MTO regulations.
- Accurately maintaining vehicles and/or equipment records by recording service and repairs to MTO regulations, keep shop equipment operating by following operating instructions, and maintain necessary supplies.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Supervisor.
- Will be exposed to inclement weather, dirt, dust, debris, noise, etc.

Qualifications

- The minimum level of formal education required for the position is High School (Grade 12) plus achievement of two (2) trade licenses- Truck and Coach Technician (310T), and Automotive Service Technician (310S)
- Light duty and specialized equipment mechanic.
- Back up or assist in heavy duty equipment
- The position requires a valid Ontario Class AZ endorsed license with a satisfactory driving record.
- License or certification in the following disciplines would be an asset: propane, natural gas, ozone depletion and/or transportation of dangerous goods.
- The position requires 2 to 5 years related experience, direct municipal experience considered an asset.

- Exceptional written and verbal communication and interpersonal skills with an emphasis on customer service.
- Ability to work independently or part of a team.

As a condition of employment, the successful candidate will be required to pass a Criminal Record Check before commencement of this position.

Salary range and hours of work: Level 5 - \$65,430.78 to \$74,575.43 (2019 rate) per annum based on a 40 hour work week **also may be required for after hours or be on call**, plus a comprehensive employee benefit plan.
