Reporting to the Director of Public Works, the Manager of Transportation Services is responsible for the following:

- Overseeing all aspects of seasonal operations, preventive maintenance and repair of transportation assets, including but not limited to roads, bridges, culverts, sidewalks, fleet, equipment, service yards/garages, traffic signals, streetlights, signage and pavement markings in accordance with Corporate strategic vision and priorities, best management practices and other.
- Overseeing scope and cost management elements and ensures coordination, planning and implementation of requisite minor capital works are both on-time and on-budget.
- Coordinates the work of technical staff and retains and oversees external consultants/contractors for specialized services.
- Responsible for ensuring compliance with transportation and drainage related regulatory requirements, including Minimum Maintenance Standards, *Highway Traffic Act* and *Drainage Act*.
- Responsible for staff planning, recruitment, training, coaching and mentoring, including conducting performance reviews and determining appropriate mechanisms for success in accordance with applicable Township policies and practices.

The successful applicant will possess:

- Post-secondary Degree in Civil Engineering (P.Eng), Certified Engineering Technologist, or equivalent.
- Project Management Professional certificate an asset.
- Working towards or commitment to obtain Certified Roads Supervisor designation.
- Eight (8) years of progressive management experience in municipal transportation operations and service delivery.
- Broad knowledge of construction technology for roads, storm sewers and buildings.
- Demonstrated experience with coaching, motivating and managing a multi-disciplinary team of technical and professional staff.
- Valid class G driver's licence in good standing with own vehicle to use on corporate business.
