Nomination Process



1. A notice is sent to all member municipalities and First Nations (First Call for Nominations) soliciting nominations.
 - a. The Nomination Consent form must be signed by two eligible persons¹.
 - b. A Council resolution is not required however is acceptable.
 - c. The Nomination should include résumé.
2. The Nominating Committee will meet to review nominations and recommend a slate of candidates to the Board of Directors.
3. The Board of Directors will consider the report of Nominating Committee and may accept, amend or refer the report back to the Committee.
4. Once the Board approves the Slate of Candidates a notice is sent to all member municipalities and First Nations (Second Call for Nominations) advising of the recommended slate of candidates and advising that additional nominations can be submitted.
5. Candidates who initially submitted a Nomination but who were not on the recommended Slate of Candidates may re-submit their Nomination if they wish to contest the slate.
6. If no additional nominations are received by the deadline, the recommended slate of candidates will be declared elected during the Opening Session at the OGRA Annual Conference.
7. If additional nominations are received by the deadline, a notice of poll will be issued, and an election² will be held during the OGRA Annual Conference to determine who will sit on the Board. For information on the Election process please [click here](#).

¹ Eligible Person shall be anyone who is elected to council or who works full-time for an OGRA member municipality or First Nations community. They do not need to come from the same municipality as the nominee.

² While Candidates are nominated from OGRA Zones, all electors can vote for all candidates regardless which Zone the candidate or elector is from.
